### -Hunt Sewer Study

The public presentation has been finalized and is scheduled for May 27, 2023 at 2 PM at the Loon Lake Chapel

A grant application will be submitted in June. There is no need for a sewer district to be voted on for this grant to be submitted.

Hunt hopes to have an estimate on costs for connecting into the current Wayland Treatment Plant (Tie in to the current Wayland system)
